

Government funded Summer School at Arnold Hill Spencer Academy 9th – 13th August 2021

- Students targeted were all our Year 7 intake for September with a particular focus on:
 - Students coming from our smaller feeder schools
 - Students requiring extra transition support
- Approximately 60 students per day attended, we had 100 places allocated for each day, however all 275 were invited to attend
- Our local MP Tom Randall visited to see how the students were getting involved
- The programme was led by an external company ‘*The Independent Learning Group*’ (TILG) and supported by Arnold Hill staff
- The aim was to develop positive relationships, collaborative working whilst including elements of numeracy and literacy
- Activities the students took part in were:
 - Design a Rollercoaster Challenge incorporating numeracy, literacy and oracy skills, technology, art and design
 - Zorb Football
 - Nerf Wars
 - Escape Room
 - Music workshops
