Re: Year 10 visit to the Thackray Museum of Medicine in Leeds, Friday 7th January 2022

I am pleased to inform you that this year the History department is running a visit for Year 10 students to the Thackray Museum of Medicine in Leeds **on Friday 7th January 2022**.

This optional visit is designed to accompany our GCSE unit Medicine Through Time which the students have been learning about since the start of this year. Students will have the opportunity to participate in a teacher led trail of the museum and join in a workshop. The cost of the visit is £21.00; this includes entrance to the museum and return travel by coach.

We will be leaving school at 8.45am promptly. In order for a timely departure, students on the visit should arrive at Snack Chat in B Block at 8.20am for registration. We will return to school at approximately 16.00pm, and students will be expected to make their own way home. Students will be allowed to use their phones to contact home if there is a problem with traffic on the journey home. Lunch is not provided and students will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks for the day. If your child receives free school meals, the Academy will provide a packed lunch upon request. All students are expected to wear full school uniform on the day. Students may also bring around £15 spending money if they wish to purchase anything from the gift shop.

The number of places available on this visit is limited due to venue capacity. Should we receive more consent forms than there are places available, we will select names randomly after the closing date.

If a place for your child is confirmed, you will be notified in writing and asked to pay in full through SCOPAY by Thursday 9th December 2021. If your payment is not received by the deadline the place previously offered will be withdrawn.

If we are unable to confirm a place for your child through random selection, we will offer them a place on the reserve list.

Any monies paid may be non-refundable should your child withdraw or be removed from the visit. We reserve the right to exclude from this visit, at any point, any student whose behaviour gives us cause for concern.

Please note, payments will be non-refundable once the tickets have been paid for.
