**Re: Visit to see ‘An Inspector Calls’ at Theatre Royal, Nottingham - 18<sup>th</sup> January 2023**

The English department would like to invite our current Year 9 students to take part in a visit to a matinee performance of JB Priestley’s ‘An Inspector Calls’ at the Theatre Royal, Nottingham on Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> January 2023.

The visit will give students the opportunity to view a live theatre performance of the set text which they study for their GCSE English Literature examination. It will offer a valuable insight of the play and develop students’ understanding of the studied text; attendance would therefore be beneficial.

**The cost of the visit is £30.00;** this includes a theatre ticket and return travel by coach.

Students will attend their morning lessons as normal and are expected to wear their full school uniform. After they have eaten lunch students will meet at the Plaza for 1pm for registration. We will leave school promptly at 1.15pm. Depending on the traffic on our journey home, we expect to return to the Academy by 4.30pm. Students will then make their way safely home following their usual arrangements.

Students may also bring a small amount of money to buy an ice cream or programme at the interval.
